APPL	ICATION	MATERIALS
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The application form and all required materials must be submitted electronically by **12 p.m. (noon) on Monday**, **March 18, 2024**. Applications will not be accepted if they are late, incomplete or if the personal statement exceeds the maximum page length. The completed application should be e-mailed to the Student Trustee Selection Committee (c/o Board of Trustees Office) at <u>board@osu.edu</u>. Importantly, completed applications will be evaluated and screening interviews will be held to identify finalists for consideration. The screening interviews will be conducted on either Saturday, March 23 or Sunday, March 24, 2024, and candidates must be available for interviews on those dates to be considered.

Your application must be complete at the time of submission. A complete application includes:

- 1. The basic application form, signed and completed
- 2. An up-to-date résumé and/or curriculum vitae
- 3. Transcripts from all colleges and universities you have attended (*Note: Pass/Non-Pass grades due to the pandemic will not be viewed negatively during the review process*)
- 4. A current copy of your OSU Advising Report, if available
- 5. Two letters of recommendation to support your application (*Note: Please ask your recommenders to submit their letters directly to <u>board@osu.edu</u>)*
- 6. A personal statement addressing your interest in the position
- 7. Answers to a series of short essay questions

Letters of Recommendation

Your application must be supported by two letters of recommendation, submitted electronically by your recommenders directly to the Board Office at <u>board@osu.edu</u>. At least one of the letters must be written by an individual who is affiliated with The Ohio State University (e.g., current or former faculty or staff member). Please ask your recommenders to include your FULL NAME in the subject line of their email. This is crucial, as this is how the Board Office will match your letters to your application materials. The Board Office must receive your letters electronically no later than 12 p.m. (noon) on Monday, March 18, 2024, in order for your application to be considered complete and eligible for consideration.

Personal Statement

Your personal statement should be no longer than three pages, double-spaced, with one-inch margins and using Times New Roman 12 pt font in Microsoft Word. Topics to cover in your statement:

- a) Any work, service and leadership experiences you believe are relevant to your candidacy
- b) A discussion of your thoughts on trusteeship
- c) Your definition of leadership and how you as a trustee would fulfill this definition

Short Essay Questions

Please provide answers to the questions below. Your responses should be 250 words or less per question, double-spaced, with one-inch margins and using Times New Roman 12 pt font in Microsoft Word.

- a) What do you think is the most important skill or quality required to successfully fulfill the responsibilities of a student trustee? Please elaborate on how you demonstrate this skill/quality.
- b) What experience at Ohio State has had the most profound impact on you? Please describe.
- c) Briefly discuss what you believe are the major issues facing Ohio State and the Board of Trustees.
- d) Briefly discuss your current major time commitments and how those would continue during your time as a trustee. Additionally, please describe your expectations of the time commitment for this role.
